CSSP condemns all violent incidents that took place in South Serbia in the last weeks.

We welcome and support all official statements of the Republic of Serbia as well as of the local governments in South Serbia that spoke out against these criminal acts.

We urge all officials of the Republic of Serbia and the local governments to condemn all forms of violence and to de-escalate the situation.

We therefore appeal to the state government as well as to the local governments in South Serbia to come together as democratic leaders in the Republic of Serbia and to communicate about how to prevent further violence.

What the public needs is a powerful sign of cooperation to discourage the criminal forces, which have an interest in keeping South Serbia unstable, thereby preventing the further social, economic and cultural development of the region.

This is the time to improve cooperation and stand together in unity across communities.
